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Frequently Asked Questions...

What are the housing arrangements? My child is attending with a sibling/friend, will they be able to room together? My children are attending the same session but in different programs, will they still see each other? Where are meals served? What about special diets? Is there adequate supervision? How many children will be in each session? Who are the counselors? What medical facilities are available? What equipment and clothing should be sent?

The Camp is set up with cabins that each house 8 campers and 2 counselors. Campers can request their roommates regardless of whether they are in the same program or not. All Campers meet to enjoy meals and outdoor adventures together. Meals are served in the Dining Hall buffet-style and are amply supplied with fresh vegetable and fruit dishes. Fresh fruit snacks are always available. Special diets can be accommodated with adequate notification. Players will be grouped by skill level on arrival at camp.

The ratio of counselors to campers are 4:1 in tennis, housing, and outdoor adventures. There is a maximum of 64 children enrolled in each session. The Camp's counselors are hand-picked, licensed professionals, certified in emergency medical techniques. The Camp's Nurse is available 24-hours a day, a Doctor is on call, EMS response time is 10 minutes, and a hospital is only 20 minutes away. Homesick children can call home whenever they feel the need, and there is a telephone receptionist always on duty.

Campers are supplied with all the safety equipment needed to participate in outdoor adventures. The summer climate in the Blue Ridge Mountains averages in the 80's during the day with temperatures dropping to the 60's at night. Clothing needed will be plenty of shorts and t-shirts, rain gear, swimming suits and water shoes, tennis shoes, and hiking boots and jeans for horseback riding. Campers should bring their own tennis racquets.

What are the activities on the weekends? How many weeks do most campers stay? What if my child wishes to stay for another session? What if my child wishes to change programs during a session?

On the 360 acres encompassing the Camp there is a 2-acre swimming pond, 1.5 miles of river frontage, mountains and woods to explore, and beautiful vistas to enjoy. In addition, weekend activities involve visiting Blue Ridge attractions and festivals. To best maximize skill acquisition, a two-week stay is encouraged. If Campers wish to extend their stay into another session, as long as there is space available, and you can bear to be parted from your child another week, that is permissible. Once Campers are enrolled in a program they will need to complete that session before changing programs. There are available mixed programs of Tennis and Adventure.
